## Concealed Handgun Class

### Training Requirements

1. The weapon used for training must be in good working order and equipped with a hammer block, firing pin lock or other type of approved mechanism to prevent an accidental discharge if accidentally dropped. There will be no exceptions to this rule!
2. No hot loads or reloads will be allowed. The student will need a minimum of 100 rounds.
3. The student must be able to demonstrate a general knowledge of the North Carolina Law on Concealed Handguns, handgun safety, and use of deadly force (written examination).
4. The student must successfully complete a proficiency test which involves the actual firing of the handgun and a performance evaluation.
5. All live fire shooting will be from a holster secured to the hip with a belt. A right hand shooter will use a right hand holster and a left hand shooter will use a left hand holster. (No cross draw holsters.)

### **HANDGUN PERMIT AUTHORIZATION**

It is a five (5) year felony for any person to possess or carry, whether openly or concealed any gun, rifle, pistol, or other firearm on any educational property such as Western Piedmont Community College. Exceptions are legal only for certified educational training on our firing range.
