The courses offered in the Manufacturing Fundamentals Certificate are designed to provide students with enhanced career opportunities in entry level manufacturing. Students will be introduced to the basic concepts of manufacturing by emphasizing the importance of Lean Manufacturing, Industrial Safety, OSHA, Forklift Training, Logistics and Understanding the Basics of a Manufacturing Business. The fundamentals course includes training in core concepts such as measurements and mathematics, teamwork, communications and problem solving.
