### Requirements:

- Active CNA I listing on the NC DHSR registry with no substantial findings
- Active CPR certification
- Copies of valid Driver's License and Social Security card with matching names on both
- Copy of High School Diploma or GED or sealed transcript of grades
- Recommended six months working experience as a Nurse Aide I
- Letter of Recommendation from immediate supervisor
- A criminal background check is required and will be done the first week of class FREE to students
