Students who are eligible for Early Registration and want to register through Pioneer Pass should follow the steps outlined below. Students who wish to register using the traditional method, please see Page 2.

1. **SEE YOUR ADVISOR DURING ADVISING WEEK** **JULY 6 - 10, 2009**
 - ▶▶ Make an appointment with your advisor to develop a course schedule
 - ▶▶ Advisor will remove WEB restriction and review for other flags that may prohibit registration
 - ▶▶ Advisor will give you a copy of the registration card to use when registering online during the week of July 13 - 17, 2009 (The original will be submitted to Student Services.)

2. **REGISTER FOR CLASSES DURING REGISTRATION WEEK** **JULY 13 - 17, 2009**
 - ▶▶ If you were enrolled Fall 2008, Spring 2009 and/or Summer 2009 and if you have earned **30 SHC OR MORE** at WPCC, you are able to register online using Pioneer Pass on Monday, July 13, 2009 beginning at 7:00am through Friday, July 17, 2009 at 1:00pm.
 - ▶▶ If you were enrolled Fall 2008, Spring 2009 and/or Summer 2009 and if you have earned **29 SHC OR LESS**, you will be able to register online using Pioneer Pass on Tuesday, July 14, 2009 beginning at 7:00am through Friday, July 17, 2009 at 1:00pm.
 - ▶▶ Pioneer Pass may be accessed by any computer with internet access, including: laptops, open computer labs on campus, and kiosks located in each building. A tutorial is available on the website that gives detailed instructions on how to access and register using Pioneer Pass. Pioneer Pass will periodically be unavailable for updates and maintenance, please refer to the webpage for scheduled times.

3. **PRINT YOUR SCHEDULE**
 - ▶▶ You will need to print your class schedule if you receive any form of Financial Aid or if a third party (WIA, TAA, VA, etc.) is paying your tuition, fees, and books. This printout is necessary for certain Business Office functions and to purchase books in the Book Cellar. Please write your last name and student identification number on the printout prior to taking it to the Business Office or Bookstore. There will be a printer connected to each kiosk for your convenience.

4. **PAY TUITION AND FEES**
 - ▶▶ Please refer to page 21 for complete steps to paying for your tuition and fees.

4 STEPS TO COMPLETE TRADITIONAL EARLY REGISTRATION

- 1. SEE YOUR ADVISOR DURING ADVISING WEEK - JULY 6 - 10, 2009.**
Make an appointment and meet with your advisor during advising week to arrange a schedule and complete a registration card. Advisor will remove registration restriction and review for other restrictions that prohibit registration.
- 2. REGISTER FOR CLASSES DURING REGISTRATION WEEK THROUGH PIONEER PASS OR WITH YOUR ADVISOR OR DIVISION ASSISTANT - JULY 13 - 17, 2009**
 - If you have earned **30 SHC OR MORE** at WPCC and are eligible for early registration, you are able to register on Monday, July 13, 2009 beginning at 8:00am.
 - If you have earned **29 SHC OR LESS** at WPCC or if you were unable to register on July 13, and are eligible for early registration, you may register beginning Tuesday, July 14 at 8:00 am and ending July 17 at 1:00pm.

3. PICKUP SCHEDULE
Pick up your schedule in Division Assistant's office prior to payment of tuition and fees.

SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENT PROCEDURES

- Schedule Adjustments are only permitted on scheduled days (see page 2).
- Meet with advisor. If not available, meet with Division Dean.
- A 25% fee may be assessed if schedule adjustments are made after regular registration.
- Late registration into a class is only permitted if the class has not met.
- Tuition refund of 75% is available during the first 10% of the semester. Students must sign a Tuition Refund Form located in the Registrar's office. Refunds will be mailed 6 to 8 weeks after registration is complete.

WPCC TOBACCO POLICY EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2009

Western Piedmont Community College has a responsibility to its students and employees to provide a safe and healthy environment. IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR FINANCIAL AID STUDENTS

- Financial Aid award amounts listed on your award letter are based on full time enrollment. **IF YOU ARE NOT ENROLLED IN AT LEAST 12 CREDIT HOURS, YOUR AWARD AMOUNT WILL BE REDUCED PROPORTIONALLY ACCORDING TO HOURS ENROLLED: ¾ TIME ENROLLMENT, ½ TIME ENROLLMENT, OR LESS THAN ½ TIME ENROLLMENT.**
- It is highly recommended that you visit the Financial Aid Office if you are enrolled less than full time and you are not absolutely certain that your financial aid will cover tuition/fees. If your financial aid award amount does not cover your tuition/fees, the Business Office will bill you for the difference.
- Financial Aid students are REQUIRED to present their Registration Statement to the Bookstore before purchasing books with financial aid.
- If there is a credit balance in your account after Tuition/Fees and books have been taken out a financial aid refund check will be mailed to the current address on record. Please inform the College immediately of any change in address.
- Tuition Refund Policy (Applicable dates are listed on page 2):
 1. 100% of tuition will be refunded to students withdrawing from classes before the first day of the academic term.
 2. 75% of tuition will be refunded to students withdrawing from classes before the 10% point of the term. This means that the student will be financially responsible for the 25% portion of tuition not refunded, regardless of the source of funding (Pell Grants, Scholarships, etc.).
 3. No refund will be given for classes dropped after the 10% point of the semester. This means the student will be financially responsible for 100% of tuition and fees, regardless of the original source of funding (Pell Grants, Scholarships, etc.).

BUSINESS OFFICE PROCEDURES

FINANCIAL AID

- * Contact with Accounts Receivable in the Business Office or Financial Aid is highly recommended to verify financial aid amounts.
- * Classes are not dropped unless an official schedule adjustment is completed.
- * BOOKSTORE: Registration Statement is REQUIRED for bookstore purchases.

SPONSORED PARTIES (TUITION AND FEES BILLED TO OUTSIDE AGENCY)

- * An authorization form from the paying agency must be in the Business Office before tuition and fees can be billed to an outside agency.
- * Student may be billed directly if the outside agency has a dispute regarding the courses or bookstore purchases.
- * BOOKSTORE: Registration Statement stamped from Business Office personnel is REQUIRED for bookstore purchases.

PAYING STUDENTS

- * **FULL PAYMENTS – Business Office**
 - o Registration Statement must be taken to the Business Office for payment with cash, check, money order, Visa, MasterCard, or Discover.
 - o Checks must have the following information: street address, phone number, drivers license number and a telephone number
 - o The drop box located outside the business office may be used during the registration period for check, money order, or credit card payment (Visa, MasterCard, or Discover).
 - o The balance must be paid in full or classes will be dropped.

INTEREST-FREE MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN

To help you meet your educational expenses, Western Piedmont Community College is proud to offer FACTS as a convenient budget plan. This is not a loan program. There are no interest or finance charges assessed, and there is no credit check. You may budget your tuition and fees in the following ways:

A. Automatic Bank Payment (ACH) – ACH payments are those payments you have authorized FACTS to process directly with your financial institution. It is simply a bank-to-bank transfer of funds that you have pre-approved for your expenses at Western Piedmont Community College. Payments may be made from either your checking or savings account. Payments are processed on the 5th of each month and will continue until the balance is paid in full.

B. Credit Card Option – Paying with your credit card gives you the option of taking advantage of any bonus programs that may be offered by your credit card company. Your monthly payment will be automatically charged to the credit card you designate. Payments will be charged on the 5th of each month until the balance is paid in full.

- * To protect your privacy, you will need to create your own unique FACTS Access Code. Please be sure it is something you can easily remember.
- * Account information for the person responsible for payment.
- * If paying by automatic bank payments, you will need the bank name, telephone number, account number, and the bank routing number. Most of this information is located on your check.
- * If paying by credit card, you will need the credit card number and expiration date.

Please print a copy after you submit your agreement. This is for your records and confirmation of your agreement.

DOWN AND FULL PAYMENT OPTIONS

Down or full payments are deducted immediately from the account provided on the agreement. If the payment fails for any reason, the agreement is terminated and notification is sent to the person responsible for payment. A \$2.00 per semester nonrefundable FACTS Enrollment Fee will be assessed for full payments. The cost to budget your monthly payment plan is a \$25.00 per semester nonrefundable FACTS Enrollment Fee. ***Please do not assume your balance will automatically be adjusted if financial aid is received or a class is dropped or added. You are still obligated for payments even if your classes are dropped. You should review your agreement balance online through My FACTS Account or call the Western Piedmont Community College Business Office at (828) 448-6025 to confirm the change.***

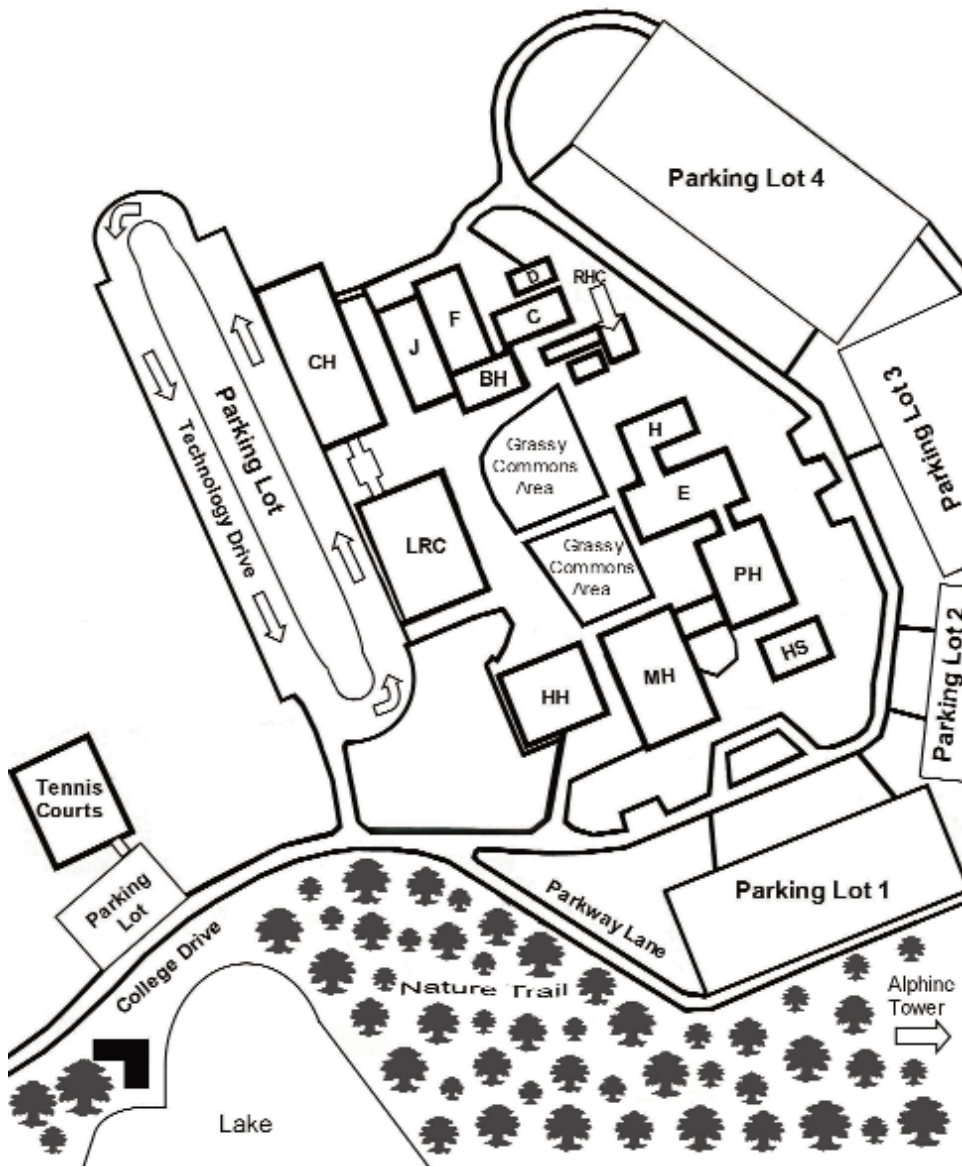
